





“Leadership in organizations is **the process of (*wisely*) guiding and directing the behavior of people in the work environment.**” (Quick and Nelson, 2013: 380, *italics author’s*). **Leaders influence their people** (Maxwell, 1993; Low, 2013); and very often **the people will look at the leaders as role models** (Price and Price, 2013; Low, 2013; Peterson and Seligman, 2004) for their growth and progress. And people would also look at their leaders and their behaviors as standards (Price and Price, 2013).






