- Highest Among Competitor Nations
- Mixed System of Socialized Sector and Private Sector
- Highest Per Capita Surgeries
- Highest Consumption of Prescription Drugs

EDUCATION SECTOR

- Real Estate Tax based Discriminatory Educational Funding
- "Best Graduate Schools and the Worst Public Schools"
- DISCONNECT between the Needs of the Workplace and People Looking for Jobs!
- Cost-Benefit Numbers Trending Against the Value of College Education
- "Certification/Badges" Are More Important than Degrees to Many Employers
- Demographic Cliff
- Record Numbers of Colleges are Closing or Merging
- Too MANY college graduates?

LITIGATION COSTS

- In EXCESS of \$500 billion almost 3% of U.S. GDP
- \$3500 per Household
- US companies spend almost 200% more on Legal Costs than their competitors. (2017 Study)
- Legal Considerations DISTORT appropriate decision making.
- Misallocation of resources
- Example Physicians ordering unnecessary tests.
