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

(S)e also listens well. "Wisdom is the eward you get for a lifetime of listening when you'd have referred to talk" (Doug Larson cited in Deep and Sussman, 000: 58). And it is often and indeed good to seek the pinions of one's people (Matsushita Konosuke once implied nese, cited in PHP Institute Inc., 1994). It is also good to be onsultative (Matsushita Konosuke spoke of these; PHP) stitute Inc., 1994), and the leader too learns a thing or two om his (her) people.






